THE 4 KEY ACTIONS

- Keep your phone off the dancefloor
- Avoid intrusive lights
- Prioritize presence and listening
- Ask permission before photographing

HOW TO APPLY IT

Slide the phone in your pocket — and forget it. If you need it, step off the floor. For photos, always ask permission.

WHY IT MATTERS

Collective intimacy and the right to live without being filmed. Your real presence, your unfiltered pleasure. Others' right not to be captured without consent.

WHEN TO APPLY IT

As soon as you hit the dancefloor. Before reflexively lighting up your screen. When the urge to document outweighs the urge to live the moment.

WHAT THIS CONCRETELY IMPLIES

- Keep your phone off the dancefloor as much as possible
- Avoid any intrusive light (screen, flash, video)
- Prioritize presence, eye contact, listening and movement

LEGAL FRAMEWORK

In Québec, every person has the right to respect of their private life and their image (Charter of Rights, art. 5; Civil Code, art. 35-36). Photographing or filming without consent may constitute a violation of these rights.
